## SIND ACT No. IV OF 1935.1

THE IDENTIFICATION OF PRISONERS (SIND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1935.

[13th April, 1935.]

An Act further to amend the Identification of Prisoners Act, 1920, in its application to the Province of Sind].

XXXIII of 1920.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Identification of Prisoners Act, 1920, in its application to the [Province of Sind] for the purposes hereinafter appearing; And whereas the previous sanction of the Governor General required by sub-section (3) of section 8oA of the Government of India Act has been obtained for 5 and 6 Geo. V. c. 61. the passing of this Act; It is hereby enacted as follows:-

> I. (I) This Act may be called the Identification of Prisoners Short title. and extent. (3[Sind] Amendment) Act, 1935.

(2) It extends to the whole of the Province of Sind1.

2. For section 4 of the Identification of Prisoners Act, 1920 Amendmen of section XXXIII of the following shall be substituted, namely: 4 of XXXI 1920. of 1920.
