

SIND ACT No. IV OF 1935.¹[THE IDENTIFICATION OF PRISONERS (SIND AMENDMENT)
ACT, 1935.]

[13th April, 1935.]

*An Act further to amend the Identification of Prisoners Act, 1920, in its application to the ~~Province of Sind~~.*XXXIII of
1920.5 and 6 Geo.
V. c. 61.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Identification of Prisoners Act, 1920, in its application to the ~~Province of Sind~~ for the purposes hereinafter appearing; And whereas the previous sanction of the Governor General required by sub-section (3) of section 80A of the Government of India Act has been obtained for the passing of this Act; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Identification of Prisoners ^{Short title.}
(3[Sind] Amendment) Act, 1935. ^{and extent.}

(2) It extends to the whole of the ~~Province of Sind~~.
